

SUPPLIES

Residents are responsible for the following personal items (staff can assist with sourcing covered items through insurance or Medicare when eligible):

- Personal hygiene products (toothbrush, shampoo, razors, etc.)
- Medical supplies (gauze, syringes, testing strips, etc.)
- Ostomy or urological supplies (catheters, collection bags, etc.)
- Incontinence supplies (briefs, pads, wipes, etc.)

MEDICATIONS

Medications are provided through **McLaughlin Pharmacy**. Residents are responsible for all medication costs (prescription and over-the-counter). If a resident opts for a mail-order or local pharmacy, they or a family member must manage all refills. Facility staff assist with refill coordination for those using the in-house pharmacy.

FEE SCHEDULE

LEVEL OF CARE CHART & CHARGES

Level 1 - No Additional Charge

- Minimal assistance with daily living tasks
- Self-care for oxygen, colostomy, or urinary catheter

Level 2 - \$5.00/day

- Moderate assistance with personal hygiene, showering, and ambulation
- Verbal cueing for Alzheimer's/Dementia
- Stress incontinence or oxygen/catheter maintenance by staff

Level 3 - \$7.00/day

- A Residents requiring Level 3 care will be transferred to a higher-level facility.
 - Total assistance with daily living, ambulation, and hygiene
 - AM/PM care support
 - Moderate Alzheimer's/Dementia requiring frequent direction
 - Incontinence management 2–3 times daily

Assessment Process

All residents are assessed before admission and reviewed quarterly thereafter. Should a resident's needs become too complex, North Ridge Center will support a safe transition to a more appropriate care setting.
